Task One: Submit a Request for Advice


User Story

As a hobbyist woodworker, I want to present an issue I have to an expert, so that I can learn how to overcome my problem.

Task Analysis

- What is it that's prompted my persona to begin the task?
 Encountering an issue which prevented her from completing her project
- 2. What will tell the persona that their task is finished?

 When she has submitted her well defined problem to an expert of her choice.
- 3. What information does the persona already know about the process? She knows she'll need to provide information about her project
- 4. What additional information does the persona need to know to complete the task? Exactly what information she'll need to provide and in what format
- 5. Finally, what tools will the persona need to complete the task? A phone to take pictures and video and upload to the app.

Task Two: Schedule a Video Call

User Story

As a hobbyist woodworker, I want to schedule a video call with an expert, so that we can discuss how to solve my problem.

Task Analysis

- 1. What is it that's prompted my persona to begin the task?

 An expert confirms they can help with her submitted question
- What will tell the persona that their task is finished?
 When she has a chosen date and time for a video chat with an expert
- 3. What information does the persona already know about the process?

 She has experience with scheduling events via web interfaces and apps
- 4. What additional information does the persona need to know to complete the task? When the Expert is available for a video conversation
- 5. Finally, what tools will the persona need to complete the task? A phone to use the app and access to her own calendar
- 1. Notification "Your Question has been accepted!"
- 2. Scheduling Screen
- 3. View available dates and times for Video conversation
- 4. Select preferred time
- 5. Confirm
- 6. "Add to Calendar" option
- 7. Email confirmation



Task Two: View Feedback on a Submitted Project

User Story

As a hobbyist woodworker, I want to view expert feedback on a project I have submitted, so that I can determine if I've done a task correctly.

Task Analysis

- 1. What is it that's prompted my persona to begin the task?

 After establishing a relationship with an Expert, and submitting a project for their feedback, Drew wants to know what the expert thinks.
- 2. What will tell the persona that their task is finished?

 When they have affirmation or changes that need to be made to improve their project.
- 3. What information does the persona already know about the process? He has submitted a project and spoken with an expert previously, so he should be familiar with the app and most of its functions
- 4. What additional information does the persona need to know to complete the task? Where Project feedback is located
- 5. Finally, what tools will the persona need to complete the task? A phone to use the app
- 1. Login
- 2. Homescreen
- 3. Select "Submitted Projects"
- 4. Select the Project in question
- 5. Select "View feedback"
- 6. Watch video
- 7. Rate feedback
- 8. Choose whether or not to respond via comment.
- 9. Close and Return to Homescreen
